GCSE Results Day – Thursday 20th August 2026

Pupils are invited to collect their GCSE results in person from the Atrium between **9:00am and 11:00am**. Members of the Senior Leadership Team will be available to offer guidance and answer any questions you may have on the day.

If a pupil is unable to attend in person, results can be sent by email or collected by a nominated person. To arrange this, the following must be completed by **Friday 10th July 2026**:

- Pupils must email **exams@cranbrook.education** from their school email address, clearly stating:
 - The personal email address(es) they would like their results sent to, if requesting email delivery.
 - This email address needs to be copied into the email sent to us.
 - The full name of the person authorised to collect results on their behalf, if applicable.

Please note:

- Requests received after 10th July may not be processed.
- Results **cannot** be given out over the phone.
- School email accounts are not accessible from outside of the UK.
- Results will only be released to the pupil or to someone they have officially authorised in advance.
