HOMEWORK CATCH UP - CLARITY

All weekly homework tasks are due in at 4pm on the hand in day which is outlined in our pupil knowledge organisers. Each task is allocated time the night before the task is due in to support pupils to complete their homework independently. If pupils are unable to complete all their homework in the associated slot the night before hand in, our specialist staff are available during break, lunch and afterschool during the hand in day to provide support. These support sessions are currently added to ClassCharts, however, after parent/carer feedback, we will be removing these from ClassCharts and only using ClassCharts to notify pupils and their families when they have not completed their homework by the 4pm deadline. For this to work, we will need your support by supporting all pupils to complete their homework independently during the allocated slot and then encouraging them to seek support from their teacher the following day if they are unable to fully complete it.

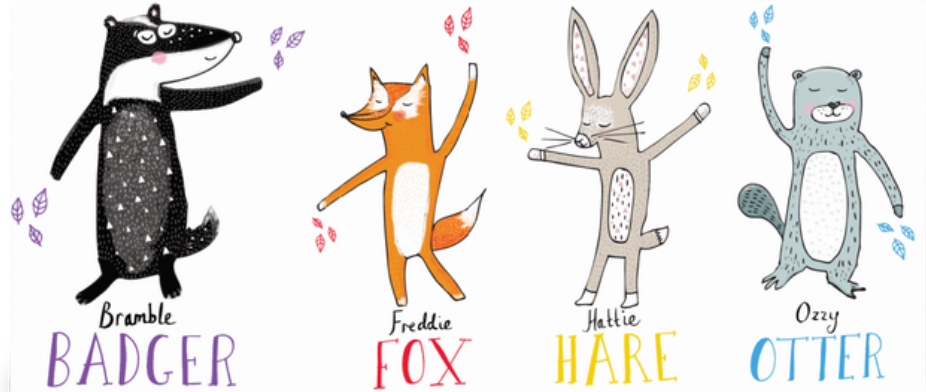
