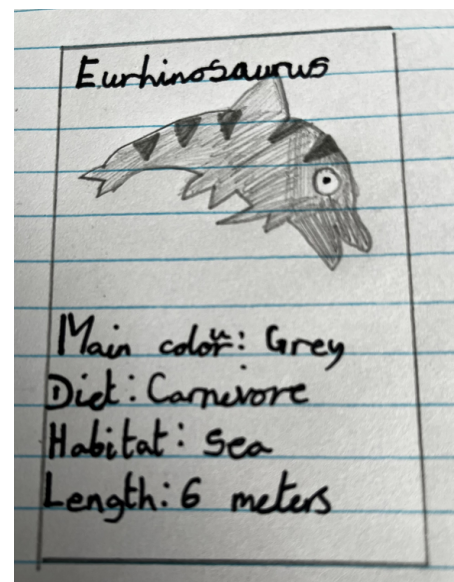
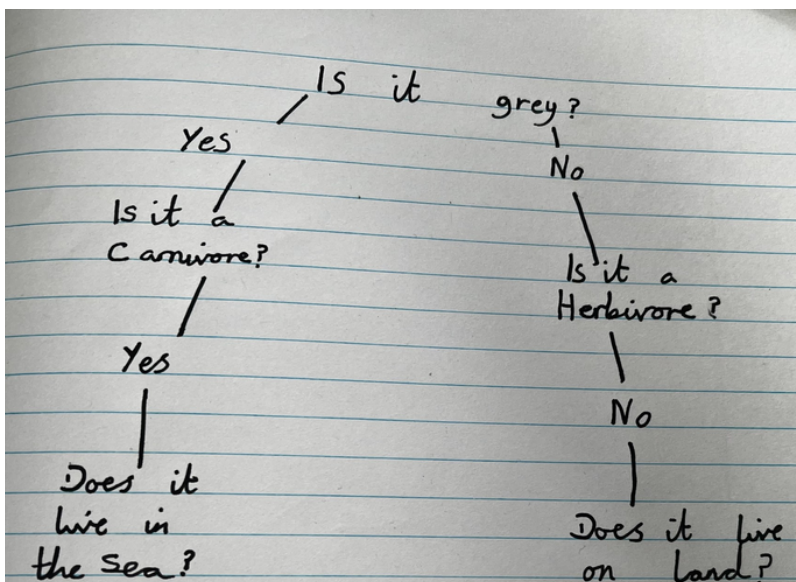
YEAR TWO

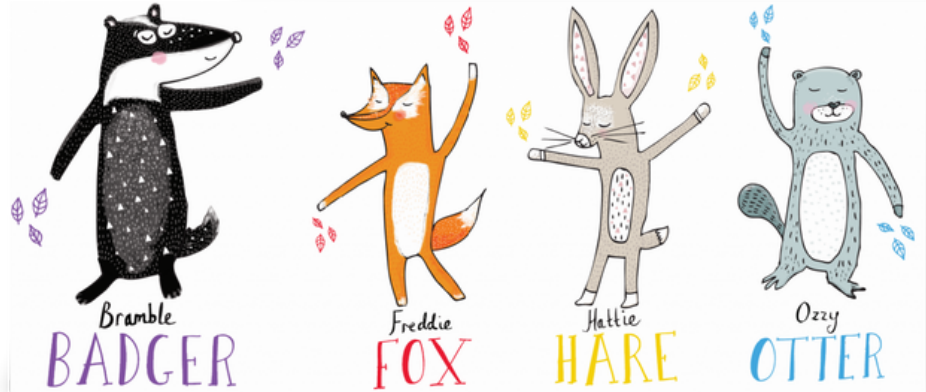

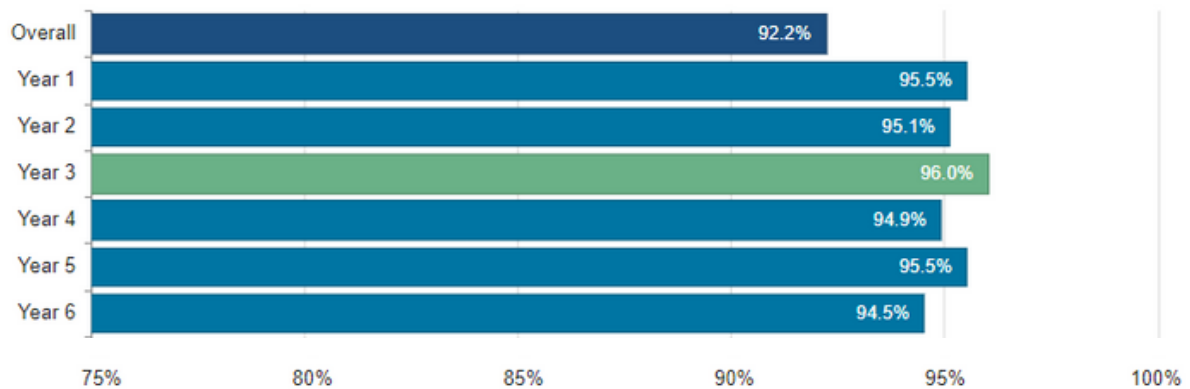
