NEU: Industrial Action

As you may be aware from media coverage, the National Education Union (NEU) has announced national and regional strike action on the following dates:

- Wednesday 1st February 2023
- Thursday 2nd March 2023
- Wednesday 15th March 2023
- Thursday 16th March 2023

We have evaluated the impact of the proposed action at Cranbrook Education Campus for Wednesday 1st February 2023 and have made the difficult decision to close some areas of the school as follows.

The Campus will be **open** for the following pupils:

Primary Phase:

- Nursery, Pre-school & Year 6 pupils
- Pupils with an education, health and care plan (EHCP), Children who are in care and children who are being supported by a social worker

Secondary Phase:

- Year 10 and Year 11 pupils
- Pupils with an education, health and care plan (EHCP), Children who are in care and children who are being supported by a social worker

The Campus will be **closed** for the following pupils:

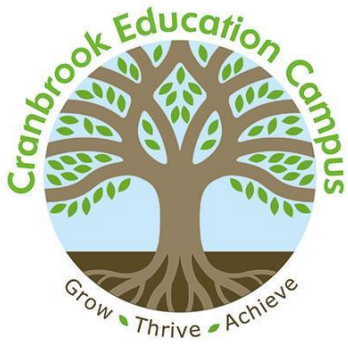
Primary phase:
